Conservation grants

The Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) has awarded two energy conservation grants that total \$50,580 to communities in Summit County to make energy-efficient upgrades in public facilities.

Lakemore has received \$25,580 to replace the chiller system at the municipal building.

Twinsburg received a \$25,000 to provide heating and cooling equipment and energy conservation improvements to qualifying low- and moderate-income households.

The awards are part of nearly \$16 million in Powering Our Communities grants NOPEC, a nonprofit government energy aggregation, will be distributing to its 129 member communities in the nine Northeast Ohio counties it serves.

The grant money came from FirstEnergy Solutions as part of an agreement the utility struck with NOPEC earlier this year.
